1. Conversational Arabic & Islamic Studies, 08/07 - 24/07 (3 weeks), 11am - 5pm, Mon & Wed

Arabic

This conversational Arabic course is based upon the famous book “Al-Arabiyyatu bayna yadayk” which was compiled in Egypt and has ever since been used in almost all language institutes to teach conversational Arabic as a second language. Students will cover 4 units studying and practicing a variety of topics that will provide key vocabulary and phrases for everyday conversation. The topics that will be covered are: acquaintances, the family, residence and daily routine

Tawheed, Fiqh and Tafsir

Series of small lessons on the most necessary things to learn. Topics covered include an explanation of the declaration of Eman, the muslim belief, fiqh of ablution and prayer and explanation of the short surahs of the Quran. The course is based on the book Al-Duroos Al-Muhimmah by one of the great scholars to have marked our century, the former Mufti of Saudi Arabia, Sheikh Abdul Aziz bin Baz.

2. Quran Reading for Fluency & Forty Hadith, 09/07 - 25/07 (3 weeks), 11am - 5pm, Tue & Thu

Quran Reading For Fluency

This course is for students who can read the Arabic script and now want to improve their fluency. It includes only the most essential tajweed rules to make practice of reading and fluency acquisition the focus. Students will read individually and as a group to a teacher and cover makharij alhuruf.

Imam Nawawi's Forty Hadith

Imam Nawawi's collection of hadith is a distillation of the foundations of Islamic sacred law. The author's aim was that “each hadith is a great fundamental of the religion, described by the religious scholars as being ‘the core of Islam’ or ‘the half of Islam’ or ‘the third of it’ or the like, and to make it a rule that these forty hadith be classified as authentic (*ṣaḥīḥ*).

3. Arabic Grammar, 08/07 - 23/09 (12 weeks), 6pm - 8.30pm / Mondays

Arabic Grammar

Arabic Grammar course for beginners will cover an introduction to Arabic grammar and is suitable for beginners. As a requirement students must be able to read Arabic. It will be based on Madinah Book One and Qur'anic Arabic.

4. Conversational Arabic, 09/07 - 24/09 (12 weeks), 6pm - 8.30pm / Tuesdays

Conversational Arabic

This conversational Arabic course is based upon the famous book Al-Arabiyyatu bayna yadayk which was compiled in Egypt and has ever since been used in almost all language institutes to teach conversational Arabic as a second language. Students will cover 4 units studying and practicing a variety of topics that will provide key vocabulary and phrases for everyday conversation. The topics that will be covered are: acquaintances, the family, residence and daily routine

5. Qur'an Hifdh, 10/07 - 25/09 (12 weeks), 7pm - 9pm / Wed or Thur

This course is aimed at students who want to memorise and perfect the Qur'an recitation. Students must already know how to read the Quran. In addition to memorising and being tested weekly, students will improve their recitation while memorising through introduction and revision of the most common Tajwid rules.
